We respect your privacy, and we want to be clear about how we handle information about you.

Who we are

The Arnhem 1944 Fellowship is a charity registered in England and Wales with registered charity number 1136441. Our registered address is 93 Church Road, Blurton, Stoke ST3 3BD.

We exist to maintain the unique bonds of friendship forged during the Battle of Arnhem, to provide a forum for veterans to record their experiences, to assist in the preservation of heritage and commemoration of the Battle and educate the public about the history.

What information is being collected?

We may collect personal data about you, including things like:

Your contact details
Your reason for joining the Fellowship
If you have made a Gift Aid declaration

How information is being collected?

Usually, we will have received this directly from you through our Membership Application form or via our online form.

We may receive information from other parties when you gave them permission to share it with us, such as members of your family or existing Fellowship members.

We may combine information that we already have about you with information available publicly or information from external sources.

How your information is going to be used?

Our use of such personal data is subject to data protection law. We mainly use your personal data to provide you with information or services you have requested, such as newsletters, and details of Fellowship events and publications.

We may also use it for other normal purposes connected with our work. For example, we will use your information to update our own records, complete statutory returns, and otherwise comply with our statutory regulations.

Who will have access to it?

We take your privacy seriously. We will never sell your personal data to anyone, and we take precautions to keep it secure.

It will sometimes be a normal and necessary part of our work to pass on information to third parties. For example, we may be obliged to pass on information to the tax authorities in some circumstances. We may pass on information to others assisting with the work we do for you.

Your choices regarding your information we hold
